A motion was made by Northup, and 2nd by Newberry to close East Fourth Street from Oak Street to the alley behind Hagy's on August 1, 2009, from 8 A.M. to 6 P.M. based on approval from the fire department.

Mayor Higgins reported that the next newsletter will be going out the first of next week.

Discussed making some improvements to the boat dock area around the old sewer plant. This will be discussed more at a later date.

It was reported that the police car has been detailed and that there is one burn in the seat. The police officer responsible for this burn is going to have the seat repaired. An additional police officer will be on duty on Saturday, July 18, for the celebration.

Discussed putting up "NO SWIMMING" signs at the city boat docks.
