OPTION 2**

Basic Service..... Collection and disposal of residential waste

Limits..... four (4) - 30 gallon cans or eight (8) bags per week

No. Of Residents..... Approximately 430 units

Collection Cycle Once per week

Collection Point..... Curbside pick up

Disposal..... All Materials to dispose at IEPA approved site.

Term of Contract 5 Years

Start Date..... TBD

Method of Payment..... Contract fee paid monthly, fees collected by City

Services Provided..... Ten (10) Toters (96 gallon Cans) to be distributed throughout the City,
2 yard for maintenance building

- Special Services.....
- a. Contractor will provide one (1) 10 yard dumpster for Festival
 - b. 8 yard dumpster emptied 1x per week for recycling
 - c. one (1) large item per month per unit

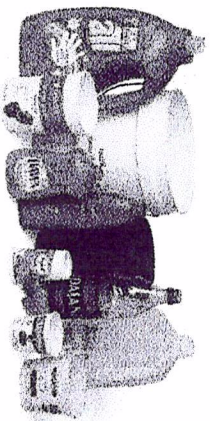
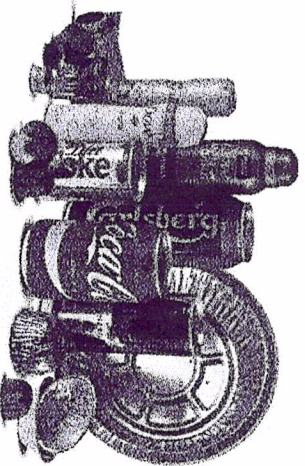
Cardboard- Corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes, beverage containers, packing and shipping boxes, paper egg cartons, soap containers, shoeboxes, and Kleenex boxes.

- **NO waxed cardboard – such as milk containers, juice boxes, No paper plates**

- **Please remove any packing peanuts or Styrofoam from the boxes.**

Miscellaneous Metals - **Such as coat hangers, bicycles, pots, pans, lawn chairs.**

Cans- Aluminum, tin, or bi-metal cans are all accepted. Labels due not have to be removed. Aerosol cans are accepted also.



Plastics – Look for the following symbol on the bottles



We accepted this symbol with the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7 inside.

#1 Plastics (PET) – such as water bottles or soda bottles clear plastic

#2 Plastics (HDPE) - such as milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, cloudy or dark colored plastic.

#3, #4, # 5 and #7 Plastics– plastic packaging, food containers

We **DO NOT** accept:

*#6 plastic – Which is Styrofoam.

* No Motor oil containers of any kind.

* Plastic bags or Zip lock, or bread bags

* NO GLASS

*No Insulin Needles (place needles in plastic container and dispose of in
