ORDINANCE NO. 669

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SNOW EMERGENCY MEASURES

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas City may enact ordinances providing for the health and safety of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Dallas City believes that establishing certain measures, protocols, and other procedures for significant, emergency-level snow fall will promote the health, safety, and overall welfare of the citizens of the City of Dallas City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF DALLAS CITY AS FOLLOWS:

- A. **Snow Emergency Defined.** As used herein, “snow emergency” shall be defined as any continuous snowfall which results in at least two (2) inches of snow build-up that remains on the ground.
- B. **Changes to Parking During Snow Emergencies.** During any snow emergency, no vehicle of any type may park, idle, rest, or cease engine function from 8:00PM until 8:00AM at the following locations:
 - B.1. On calendar days ending in an *even* number, on the west side of Oak Street between 3rd Street and the Railroad Crossing; and
 - B.2. On calendar days ending in an *odd* number, on the east side of Oak Street between 3rd Street and the Railroad Crossing.
- C. **Penalty.** Any violation of this Ordinance may result in a fine not to exceed seven-hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00), and such vehicles shall be subject to towing at the owner’s expense.
- D. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form by the authority of the Board of Trustees of the City of Dallas City, Hancock and Henderson Counties, Illinois.
- E. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
